Rules

Applies to all categories

1. Entry Fees-\$7.00 for first item, \$2.00 each for the next items. Entry fee includes admission to show (non-entrants is \$7.00) One entry per category per person. All entrants including youth, must use separate entry form. Entries must be postmarked by March 22, 2023 . Entries not submitted by that date will not be accepted.
2. Quilts must be brought to Parkview Middle School, 930 N. Rochester St. Mukwonago, WI on **FRIDAY, March 31, 2023 BETWEEN 12 noon. and 4 p.m.**
3. By signing this form you agree to allow The Crazy Quilters' Guild Inc. to use photos of you or your entry.
4. All quilts must be quilted through 3 layers by hand, machine or both. No framed items.
Construction Technique (hand pieced, machine pieced, appliqued, embroidered by hand or machine, or mixed technique)
Quilting Technique (hand quilted, stationary machine quilted, moveable machine hand guided, moveable computer guided and embroidery machine)
5. **All entries must have been completed within the last 3 years. Show committee reserves the right to accept, reject or reclassify entries. The name of the quilter must be acknowledged on entry form.**
6. **ALL** quilts are required to have sleeves for hanging. The sleeve must be 4" deep - the width of the quilt - 90" from the bottom of the quilt to the top of the sleeve. The sleeve will not be considered when the quilt is judged. The Show committee reserves the right to disqualify any quilt that does not have the required sleeve. Categories No. 23, 24, and 25 do not require a sleeve for hanging.
7. Quilting lines should be removed. Soiled items will be disqualified. NO EXCEPTIONS All labels on entries should be covered. Items entered in previous Crazy Quilters shows will be ineligible.
8. Reasonable care will be taken to prevent loss or damage to entrant's property, however, entrant agrees not to hold The Crazy Quilters' Guild, Inc. or Parkview Middle School and the Mukwonago Area School District responsible for any and all liability arising from any or all damage and loss to entrant's property.
9. Judging will be done by independent judges.
10. Quilts and prizes **MUST** be picked up between 5:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. on Sunday, April 2, 2023. A claim ticket must be shown when picking up quilts.
11. Signature on entry form implies acceptance of above rules. Entries will not be accepted without signature.
12. Limited to the first 250 entries.
13. **SHIPPED ENTRIES** may be sent to **Chris Petersen 408 Elwin Drive, Mukwonago, WI 53149 (262-363-7303 home)** entrant is responsible for all shipping charges. Insurance costs, and a current prepaid return address label must be included with your shipped entries.

No minimum perimeter, not to exceed a perimeter of 144"

4. Small Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

Minimum perimeter 145" not to exceed a perimeter of 279"

5. Large Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

Stationary Machine Quilted (quilted by entrant or another)

(i.e. domestic machine, sit down mid-arm machine)

Bed quilts must be a minimum perimeter of 280"

6. Appliqued or pieced bed size

These quilts must be a minimum perimeter of 162" not to exceed a perimeter of 279"

7. Crib or Juvenile theme
8. Lap quilt

No minimum perimeter, not to exceed a perimeter of 144"

9. Small Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

Minimum perimeter 145" not to exceed a perimeter of 279"

10. Large Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

Moveable Machine Hand Guided (quilted by entrant or another)

(includes free motion quilting, pantographs, custom quilted by hand guided machine)

Bed quilts must be a minimum perimeter of 280"

11. Appliqued or pieced bed size

These quilts must be a minimum perimeter of 162" not to exceed a perimeter of 279"

12. Crib or Juvenile theme
13. Lap quilt

No minimum perimeter, not to exceed a perimeter of 144"

14. Small Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

Minimum perimeter 145" not to exceed a perimeter of 279"

15. Large Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

Moveable Machine Computer Guided

(including embroidery machine in the hoop quilting) (quilted by entrant or another)

Bed quilts must be a minimum perimeter of 280"

16. Appliqued or pieced bed size

These quilts must be a minimum perimeter of 162" not to exceed a perimeter of 279"

17. Crib or Juvenile theme
18. Lap quilt

No minimum perimeter, not to exceed a perimeter of 144"

19. Small Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

Minimum perimeter 145" not to exceed a perimeter of 279"

20. Large Wallhanging (pieced, appliqued or pictorial)

All quilts must be quilted through 3 layers by hand, machine or both

21. 1st time entrant at any judged show, quilted by entrant, any quilting and construction technique (perimeter of 145" or more)
22. Group, made by three or more people, any size, quilting and construction technique
23. Garments and Personal Accessories
(*pieced or appliqued and quilted by entrant or another*)
24. Quilted Home Furnishings
appliqued or pieced quilted by entrant or another
(*includes quillows and pillows ...no framed items*)
25. Miniatures - quilted by entrant
(*all aspects of the quilt are in reduced scale*)
(*Not to exceed 96" perimeter*)
26. Scrap/Charm Quilts (25 or more fabrics)
hand or machine quilted by entrant or another
any construction and quilting technique
(minimum perimeter of 280")
27. Novelty (any size)
(stenciled, tied, Cathedral Window, Yo-Yo, counted cross stitch, whole cloth, and hand/machine embroidery)
can be quilted by entrant or another
28. Modern (any size)
(modern quiltsthe use of bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work.)
can be quilted by entrant or another

Youth

(Youth items must be completed entirely by entrant)

29. Youth (age 5-8) any item
appliqued or pieced; quilted or tied
30. Youth (age 9-13) any item
